Academy Nomination Application Instruction Sheet

- 1. <u>Application Packet</u>: The applicant must complete the entire application packet, even if some of the information was previously provided to another agency. Keep in mind that the applicant must be a legal resident of Oregon and reside in the Third Congressional District to be considered for nomination by Congresswoman Maxine Dexter. If the applicant is temporarily residing outside of Oregon, be sure to provide both addresses on the application form.
- 2. <u>Preference</u>: Because of the large number of qualified applicants and the limited number of nominations, each applicant is considered for his or her first choice. However, in the event that an applicant merits a nomination and the first choice is not available, the applicant will be considered for his or her second choice.

Ш	College Entrance Examination Board Scores:

The applicant is required to forward the results of his or her SAT or ACT exam to our office **directly from the testing agency**. Test scores delivered from any source other than the testing agency will not be considered. **Congresswoman Dexter's score codes are XXXX for the SAT and XXXXX for the ACT**. The applicant's counselor can provide a list of the dates these tests are being offered, and it is suggested that the applicant take the test at the earliest possible date in order to ensure that Congresswoman Dexter's office will receive the applicant's scores by our nomination deadline. We encourage students to take college entrance examinations (ACT or SAT) and have their official scores sent to us and interested academy. However, in the event a student is unable to take the tests, the Congresswoman will review the student's application without penalty.

4. Physical Requirements: Carefully review the section of the academy catalog outlining its physical requirements. Due to travel inconveniences for many applicants, the physical examination is not a prerequisite for nomination. However, the academy administers a very comprehensive physical after nominations are made, and the applicant must pass this examination in order to continue in the competition for appointment.

Congresswoman Dexter is very aware of the importance of an academy nomination to the applicant and each completed file is carefully considered on the individual applicant's own merits. To give time for a thorough evaluation of each file, it is crucial that all of the documentation requested be received in Congresswoman Dexter's District Office **by November 14, 2025.** Applicants with incomplete files will not be considered. Cooperation in supplying information at an early date is appreciated. Due to the large numbers of applications that must be processed, please be sure to notify the office if the applicant is no longer interested in competing for a nomination or if the applicant has any further questions.
